We have seen a quite start to the month with only 14 calls being attended it should be noted that 43% of these calls have been of Village style incidents and majority of them being MVA's which could be said to be because of the increase in traffic over the Christmas and New Year period, It's great to see that 80% of our calls are still 6 minutes or under.

I would like to welcome the new committee that was formed for fundraising, with talks to and with the committee members they have some great ideas to boost the funds in the brigade and buy some new equipment. We have seen some work carried out on the Cat 1 and new equipment brought through the already received donations, we have upgraded the spot lights to LED Spot lights beaming a 6300 lumens which lights up a significant area, additional LED RED/BLUE lights have been added for crew safety when attending incidents in high traffic areas or low visibility areas.
